

LABEL, IN PART: "Improved Formula Neo-Mineral—Two teaspoonfuls of this mineral extract will supply twice the minimum daily adult iron (FE) requirement. Minimum daily adult requirement 10 mgm—3 fluid ounces net."

NATURE OF CHARGE: Adulteration, Section 402 (b) (1), a valuable constituent, iron, had been in part omitted.

Misbranding, Section 403 (a), the label statement "Two teaspoonfuls of this mineral extract will supply twice the minimum daily adult iron (FE) requirement" was false and misleading. (Two teaspoonfuls of the product would supply less than twice the minimum daily adult requirement for iron, i. e., 20 mg.)

DISPOSITION: May 23, 1950. Default decree of condemnation and destruction.

LABEL FILED: July 25, 1950, Western District of New York.

ALLEGED SHIPMENT: On or about May 3, 1950, from Philadelphia, Pa.

PRODUCT: 36 1-gallon bottles of Ziratone No. 2 at Buffalo, N. Y.

NATURE OF CHARGE: Adulteration, Section 402 (b) (1), a valuable constituent, vitamin B₁, had been in whole or in part omitted or abstracted from the article.

Misbranding, Section 403 (a), the label statement "Each Fluid Ounce Contains: * * * Vitamin B₁ 6 Mgms. (600% Of The Minimum Daily Adult Requirements)" was false and misleading as applied to an article which contained less than this amount of vitamin B₁.

The article was adulterated and misbranded while held for sale after shipment in interstate commerce.

DISPOSITION: September 5, 1950. Default decree of condemnation and destruction.
